STATEMENT ON THE RUSSIAN INVASION OF UKRAINE

The President and the Board of the International Federation of Philosophical Societies share with the scholarly communities in philosophy across the world their deep distress about the current warfare in Ukraine.

As a global body in philosophy, FISP calls all scholars and philosophers to show solidarity with the intellectual communities and the people of Ukraine, in the face of the increasing human suffering that the Russian military invasion is causing in their country and beyond.

We call upon all philosophers worldwide to make their voices publicly heard and to declare that wars of aggression are unjustified in any case.

We call for an immediate end to hostilities in Ukraine and we urge world leaders to return to diplomacy and dialogue as the only appropriate way to resolve conflicts.

We reaffirm hospitality as a principle that must be extended to all individuals fleeing war, without any discrimination whatsoever.

The International Federation of Philosophical Societies is also committed to support Russian scholars who oppose the ongoing aggression despite the increasing suppression of dissent in their country.
